MALABAR BOAT OWNERS HAVE S TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS

- 1. Community membership
- 2. Junior membership
- 3. Kayak membership
- 4. Associate membership
- 5. Full membership

COMMUNITY MEMBERSHIP

The applicant for community membership must be 18 years of age or over and be nominated and seconded by two financial full members of the Club, using the appropriate application form. They are able to participate in nominated club events, but have no voting rights.

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

The applicant for junior membership of the club must be under the age of 18 years of age or under and be nominated and seconded by two financial full members of the Club, using the appropriate application form. This membership is suitable for under persons under the age 18, members are to participate in nominated club events/fishing competitions, and have no voting rights. (Limitations of boat usage apply per clubs rules). Access to MBO Facebook and WhatsApp group.

KAYAK MEMBERSHIP

The applicant for kayak membership of the Club must be of 18 years of age or over and be nominated and seconded by two financial full members of the Club in writing using the appropriate application form. They are able to participate in nominated club events/fishing competitions, have no voting rights. Kayak length requirements apply, membership type is capped. Access to MBO Facebook and WhatsApp group.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

The Applicant for Associate membership of the Club must be 18 years of age or over and be nominated and seconded by two financial full members of the Club in writing using the appropriate application form. This membership is suitable for persons that are wanting to place a boat on the skids, members are to able participate in nominated club events/fishing completions, but have no voting rights. Please note wait times for boat position is dependent on full members no longer requiring boat space. Access to MBO Facebook and WhatsApp group.

FULL MEMBERSHIP

The applicant for full membership must already be an Associate member of the Club for **three months.** At the time of three months, a letter must be sent to the committee, requesting a boat **space**. The Club is restricted to a maximum number of boats kept on the boat storage area under the terms of the Licence Agreement with Randwick Council and the Minister of Lands, hence full membership is limited. If a boat space is available and the committee has agreed to the application and upon payment of the prescribed fee, the applicant shall be deemed a full member of the Club and may then place their boat in the boat space allotted by the committee. If no boat spaces are available the **application shall be placed on a waiting list kept by the secretary with the applicant to be informed when a boat space becomes available, the applicant remaining as an associate member until that time. Suitable for persons that are wanting to place a boat on the skids, members are to able participate in nominated club events/fishing completions, and have full voting rights. Access to MBO Facebook and WhatsApp group.**
